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Entrance Criteria:

To join our Enhanced Substance Abuse Supportive Living Program, candidates must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Diagnosis of Substance Use Disorder:** Documented by a healthcare professional.
- 2. Commitment to Recovery:** Willingness to actively participate in the rehabilitation process.
- 3. Residency in Southern California:** Priority given to residents in this region.
- 4. Age Requirement:** Must be 18 years or older.
- 5. Assessment Clearance:** Passing an initial assessment to ensure compatibility with our program's capabilities.

Program Outline:

- 1. Initial Assessment:** Evaluating individual needs and developing a tailored care plan.
- 2. Therapeutic Interventions:** Includes counseling, behavioral therapy, and group sessions.
- 3. Life Skills Training:** Focusing on independent living skills, financial management, and employment readiness.
- 4. Health and Wellness:** Emphasizing physical health, nutrition, and fitness.
- 5. Community Integration:** Encouraging participation in community activities and building a support network.
- 6. Ongoing Support and Evaluation:** Regular check-ins and adjustments to the care plan as needed.

ENHANCED SUBSTANCE ABUSE SUPPORTIVE LIVING PROGRAM:

Our program utilizes the Assessment of Functional Living Skills (AFLS) to determine individual needs, focusing on essential life skills such as basic living, home management, community engagement, and vocational abilities. This ongoing evaluation ensures personalized support for each consumer.

Key to our program is teaching practical skills for daily life. This includes organizational tasks, self-care, financial management, and community navigation. The aim is to empower consumers to manage various situations independently and safely.

We regularly adjust our approach based on direct observations and consumer feedback. This collaborative process emphasizes real-life application of skills like problem-solving, social interaction, and personal management, fostering autonomy and confidence in our consumers.
